

## Conference Venue

The conference will be hosted in **Károlyi Castle** in the picturesque village of **Fehérvárcsurgó** between the towns of Mór and Székesfehérvár around 75 km west of Budapest, Hungary. The venue is located around 170 km south-east of Vienna, Austria.

Nearest railway station in Bodajk, 2 km from the venue. Frequent bus connection to Fehérvárcsurgó is available.

Bus from Győr with change in Mór or from Budapest with change in Székesfehérvár to Fehérvárcsurgó is available. Total journey time from Győr or Budapest is around 2 hours.
